APPLES – ON DWARFING ROOTSTOCK – M26

GRANNY SMITH Large, late, crisp green, exceptionally white fleshed apple, good for dessert. \$22.00
LOBO Large, flat round apple with deep red skin are ideal for cooking, eating fresh \$22.00
MACLEAR Sweet and juicy, medium sized apple, red stripes over green background. \$22.00
MERTON RUSSET Oval shaped apple, yellow flushed dull red skin, flesh green, firm crisp sweet. \$22.00
SPLENDOUR Very sweet, ripening March/April, bright red blush over yellow background. \$22.00

APPLES – MEDIUM ON MM106

GRANNY SMITH A large, late, crisp green, exceptionally white fleshed apple, good dessert. \$22.00

APPLES – MEDIUM ON MM102

GOLDEN DELICIOUS Golden Skin, sweet juicy crisp flesh, matures March. Dessert/cooking \$22.00

APPLES – TALL NORTHERN SPY

GRANNY SMITH A large, late, crisp green, exceptionally white fleshed apple, good dessert. \$22.00

CITRUS

MEYER LEMON The fruit are medium sized, mild in flavour and very juicy. Fruit mature through winter and early spring but usually has some fruit ripening all year round. Yellow almost orange coloured skin when ripe. \$13.00

CUTTING GROWN

TAHITIAN LIME Probably the best lime for the home garden as it tolerates a wide range of soil types. The fruit resemble a smooth-skinned lemon are seedless and very acid, ripening in spring mainly. **CUTTING GROWN** \$13.00

FIGS

MRS WILLIAMS Sweet table fig with purple-brown skin and amber red flesh. \$13.00

GOOSEBERRY

INVICTA Berries are veined, semi-transparent green tending to yellow when ripe. Fruit ripen in December. Resistant to powdery mildew \$13.95

GRAPES

CHAS de VERSAILLES A low acid white table and wine grape, suitable for cooler areas. \$13.00

MALUS – CRABAPPLE

- JELLY KING** Large yellow orange overlaid red fruit. Flower buds are pink opening to white. \$22.00
WRIGHTS SCARLET Large clusters of deep crimson red fruit, highly ornamental, \$22.00
Spectacular through winter and makes great jelly.

MYRTLEBERRY

Ugni moliane also know as Chilean Guava

- A neat evergreen shrub with small leathery leaves that often turn red. Fruit are scarlet red, round in shape and similar to Cranberry. Ripen in Feb. \$7.00

ORANGEBERRY *Rubus pentalobus*

An evergreen ground cover which is fast growing, preferring full sun and a well drained site. Foliage is dark green and grape like that are frost tolerant. White flowers in spring followed by fruit in late December. The fruit are bell-shaped with orange flesh. Same family as Raspberry and Strawberry.

PEACHCOTT

- A cross between a peach and an apricot, which is very sweet and tasty firm texture and a golden skin colour. Matures in March, self-fertile. \$22.00

PEACHERINE

- HALEYS** Med/large fruit which is firm orange-yellow fleshed. A clingstone variety, \$22.00

PLUMS Plum Mariana rootstock, growing to 3-4 metres in height

- BURBANK** Cherry red skin, the flesh is deep yellow. Sweet flavour, and is self-fertile. \$22.00

- CHERRY PLUMS – HEARD & PERNEL** Good pollinators, as they have lots of blossom & abundant quantities of small cherry like plums useful for jam, wine etc. \$22.00

- KERERU GOLD** A med freestone plum with yellow flesh/skin. Excellent jam, bottling. \$22.00

- MILTY'S** A Billington sport, dark red skin and flesh, good for eating fresh, jams etc \$22.00

POMEGRANATE

- WONDERFUL** A multi-stemmed shrub 3 x 3 metres. Produces double red flowers through Spring and Summer. Medium sized fruit, round with a red leathery appearance. The flesh is red with a jelly-like coating that covers many seeds and has a rich Flavour that is used for fresh fruit or juice. Hot dry summers are required for Good fruiting, although it sets most fruit after a cold winter. They prefer well Drained ordinary soil. \$12.95

QUINCE

- SMYRNA** An excellent variety for all purposes, the tree produces very large fruit, at a young age. It is a strong grower and extremely productive. The fruit is a pale lemon-yellow colour with smooth skin and a distinctive aroma. The flesh is tender and sweet when cooked. Fruit matures late February to March. A self-fertile variety growing to 3-4 metres. \$22.00

WALNUT

WILSONS WONDER

- Very large nuts make this a very popular home garden variety. A vigorous tree, yet bearing very young in its life. Available on Nigra rootstock suitable for heavier soils. \$35.00

ACTINIDIA ARGUTA – COCKTAIL KIWIFRUIT

MALE & FEMALE A type of kiwifruit, size of a medium plum, hairless skin like a grape. **\$30.00**
Male needed to pollinate female. 1X male 1 X Female in a pot.

Just pop them into your mouth and eat like a grape, no seeds or pips. They love comfrey around the roots to act as a mulch and stop the soil drying out and also to provide lots of potassium, needed for heavy fruiting crops.

APPLES

MAYFLOWER A beautiful dessert apple, good for drying, cooking, and juicing. **\$22.00**

RENINETTE du CANADA A late/ very late season apple of medium size. Firm creamy white flesh, **\$22.00**
Available on MM106

VAILE EARLY A small to medium sized apple, Yellow skin with red streaks and good flavour. **\$22.00**
Available on Northern Spy.

APRICOTS Peach rootstock and plum myrobalan rootstock.

PAHI A large mid season apricot with good texture and flavour. Self fertile. **\$22.00**

TAMAKI A large/medium sized fruit, matures mid January, partially self-fertile. **\$22.00**

GRAPES

NIAGRA Very early white dessert grape, very sweet with a good mild flavour **\$15.00**

DWARF PEARS

PRINCESS Fruit have pale green skin with pink blush, are juicy and have good flavour. **\$23.00**

PLUM

DANS EARLY A red fleshed plum, medium sized, very sweet and tasty. Ripens from early December until about the 20th December. Pollination Cherry Plums **\$22.00**
